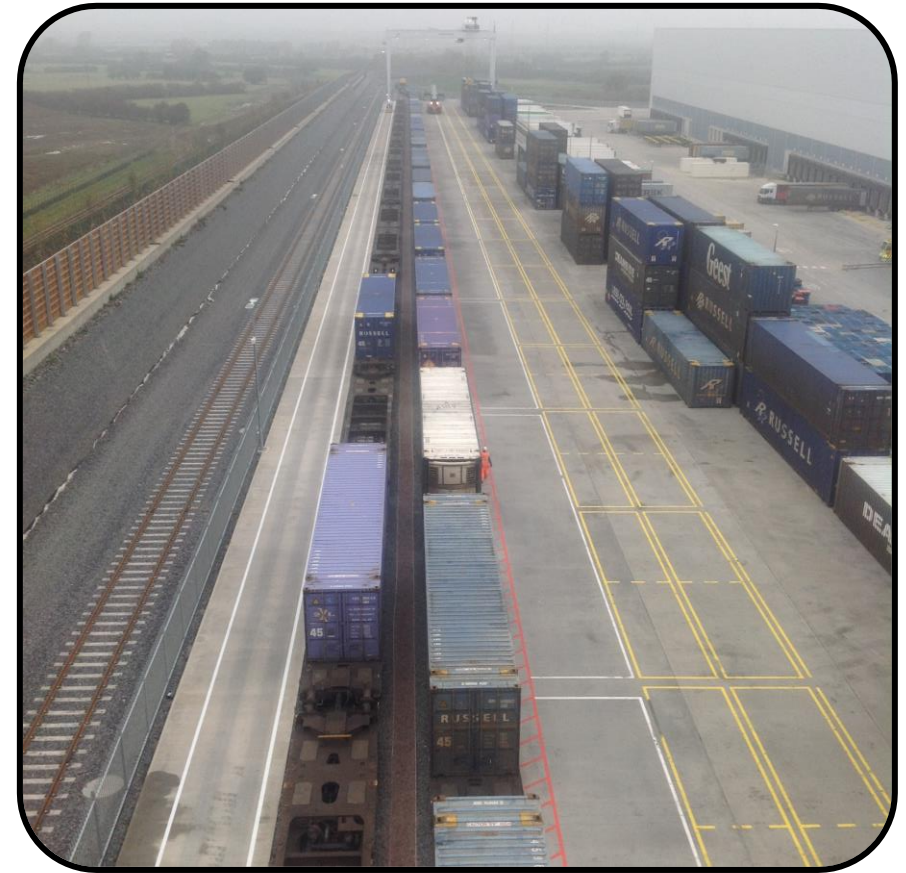

DAVENTRY RAIL FREIGHT TERMINAL

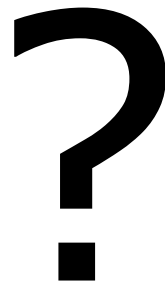


Our Daventry rail terminal operation has three daily services to Glasgow, providing new and existing customers with the flexibility to meet increasing market demands.

- Travel by rail same day from Daventry to Glasgow
- Distribution throughout Scotland by the Russell Fleet
- Movement of ambient, chilled and frozen products
- Additional peak volume and new flows into/out of Scotland
- Choice of three rail services to meet customer requirements
- Significant savings on CO2 emissions by moving from road to rail
